A Golden Deed

"Each day I'll do a golden deed" is how the song that we sing "A Beautiful Life" (written by William M. Golden in 1918) begins. As Christians, our lives are to be filled with "golden deeds." Christ Himself, our Lord and Savior, lived a sinless, perfect life here on earth, but not only that, His life was filled with "golden deeds." Jesus went about "Doing good" (Acts 10:38). Jesus' life was not only about preaching, but about performing kind deeds. As Christians, Jesus is our perfect example (1Peter 2:21). Consequently, we are to follow His example of doing good to others. (cf. Galatians 6:10)

As Christians, in our efforts to do good, we tend to think that doing something "big" and "extraordinary" is what doing good is all about. Doing good isn't about the big things, it's about the little things which Christ Himself makes clear in Matthew 25:35-40. . . vs.35 "For I was hungry and you gave Me food: I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me; I was in prison and you came to Me." . . . vs.40 "inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me." Think then, what are some ways each day, we can do "a golden deed?"

A kind word; just being there: offer help with daily chores; a shoulder to lean on; a listening ear; a cup of water, some food or clothes, etc.

We can all add to this small list, but the point is simple: doing good is not about doing the spectacular. It's not about being seen by others. Some of the greatest acts we can do are those "behind the scenes" that no one else knows about. Every day we can then do "a golden deed!" Look for opportunities and seize them, as Christ Himself did with the recognition that we will be "helping those who are in need" of something and that God Himself will be pleased.
