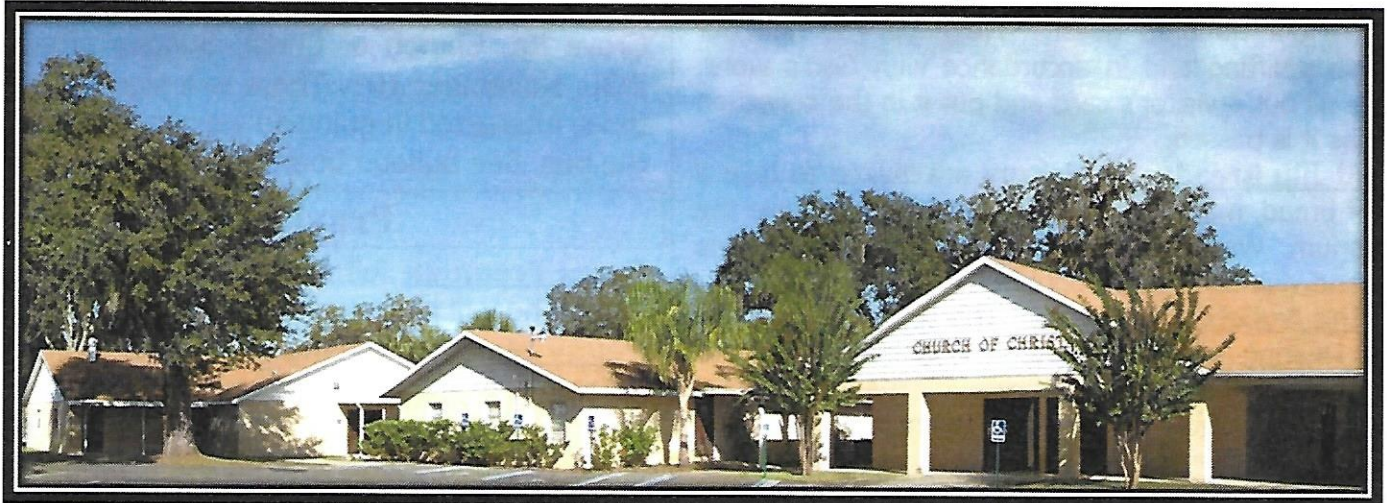

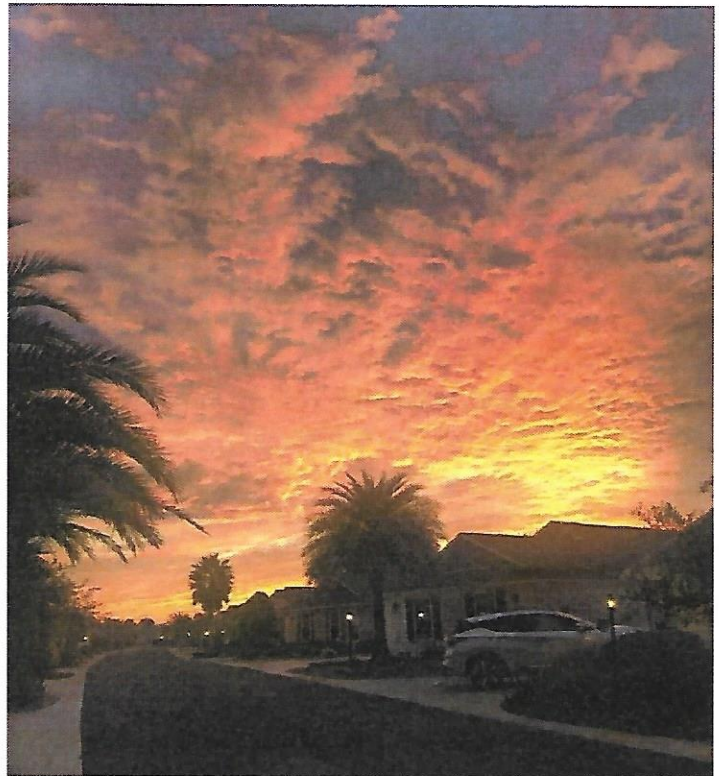

Help me be a blessing for the rest of my time and that I will make it count for eternity – **1Peter 4:1-11**

Introduction: What time do you have left? Peter had a great deal to say about "time".

1Peter 1:5, 11, 17, 20; 4:2-3, 17; 5:6

In our scripture text for today's lesson, Peter mentions four attitudes that we all can cultivate in our lifetime.

I. **First Attitude: Have a soldier's attitude toward sin - 1Peter 4:1-3**

C. Think of what you were like before you trusted and obeyed Christ. **1Peter 4:3**

1. **Philippians 3:13; Deuteronomy 5:15; 1Timothy 1:12ff**

2. What does Peter mean "the will of the Gentiles"? see **1Peter 2:11-12**

Conclusion: There is a better life to live and you can have such a life in Christ Jesus today.
