Help Me Be A Blessing Before Others

1 PETER 3:13-15, 16-17

Review: Help me cultivate true Christian love, help me sanctify Christ in my heart and help me reflect His example. **1Peter 3:8-17**

I. Jesus: Help Me Maintain A Good Conscience - 1Peter 3:16-17

A. What is conscience?

1. Our word "conscience" (Latin) means "to know with".
2. Our conscience is that internal judge that witnesses to us. see **Romans 2:14-15; Titus 1:15-16; 1Timothy 4:1-2; Hebrews 10:22**

B. What does your "good conscience" depend on?

see **1Timothy 2:15; 1Peter 1:22-23; 2:2; Acts 24:14-16**

C. How does a good conscience help a believer in times of trouble?

1Peter 3:13-14, 16-17

1. First, it fortifies us with courage because we know we are right with God and others. see **1Peter 3:16-17,18; Acts 4:8-13**
2. Second, it will give you peace in your heart. see **1Peter 3:15**
3. Third, a good conscience removes from us The fear of what others know about us, say about us or do to us.

1Peter 3:16-17

Conclusion:

Your conscience alone is not a good guide. What is our guide?

1Peter 1:23; Philippians 2:15-16
