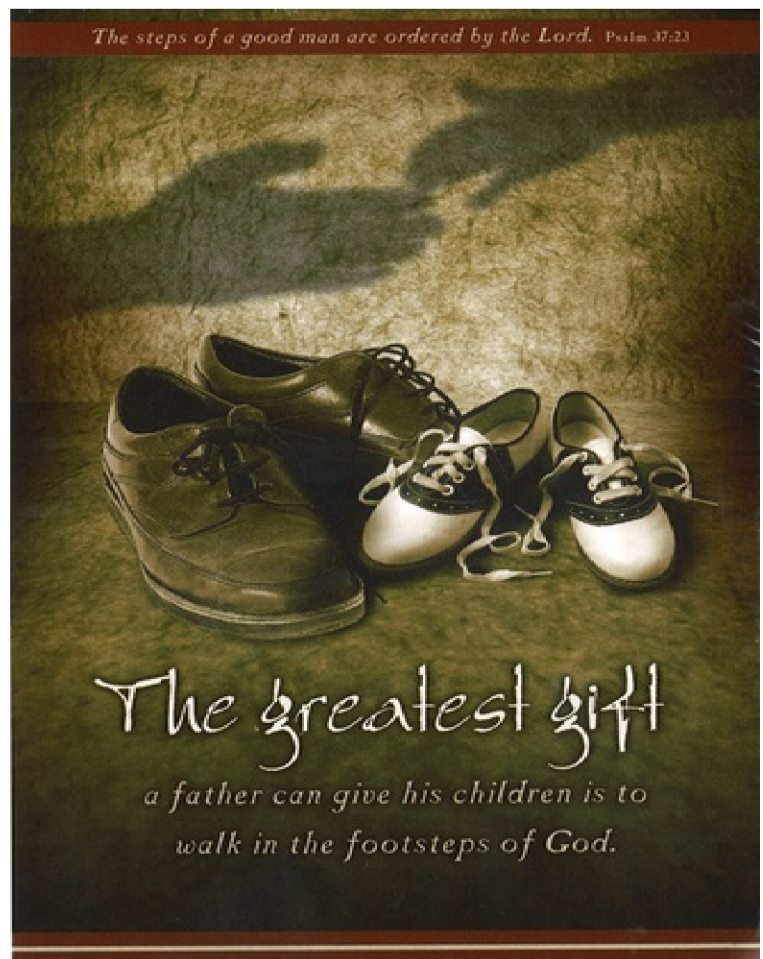

Portrait of a Father

A young father-to-be spend the evening pacing the halls of the hospital while his wife was in labor. He was tied up in knots of fear and anxiety, his face was flushed and his forehead was covered with perspiration. Finally, at 4:00p.m., a nurse opened the door to the waiting room and said, "Congratulations, sir. You have a little girl." The man heaved a sigh of relief and said, "I thank God it's a girl. She'll never have to go through the awful agony I've experienced tonight!"

Well, being a father is tough. Scripture offers us some help toward beoming the kind of father God wants us to be. In 1Thessalonians 2:1-12, Paul is discussing his apostolic ministry. One of the images he uses is that of a father, vs.11, "***Just as you know how we were exhorting and encouraging and imploring each one of you as a father would his own children.***"

Paul is saying he was like a father with his children. He dealt with each one personally. He encouraged, he comforted, he urged them to live lives worthy of God. Fathers need to do the same for their children today. Let me suggest 4 ways these three principles might play out in our lives today.

#1 Fathers pass on the **practical** life. Children often go running to father because he is the fix-it man who can make things right.

#2 Fathers are also people who make life **pleasurable**. There needs to be times of joy and fun, times of pleasure, times of laughter that rock the house, that teach us that life can be good, it can be enjoyed.

#3 Fathers are **patient**. It takes time to be the kind of father that's refelcted here in 1Thessalonias 2. Fathers need to have time on their hands and spend it generougly and lavishly with the children.

#4 Fathers are people who **praise**. Surely words of appreciation and approval come under the scope of offering encouragement and exhortation and charge to our children. Do we complain and correct more than we praise and commend?

I hope somewhere that all of us men have learned something about the ability to care and to express concern and to encourage and exhort.

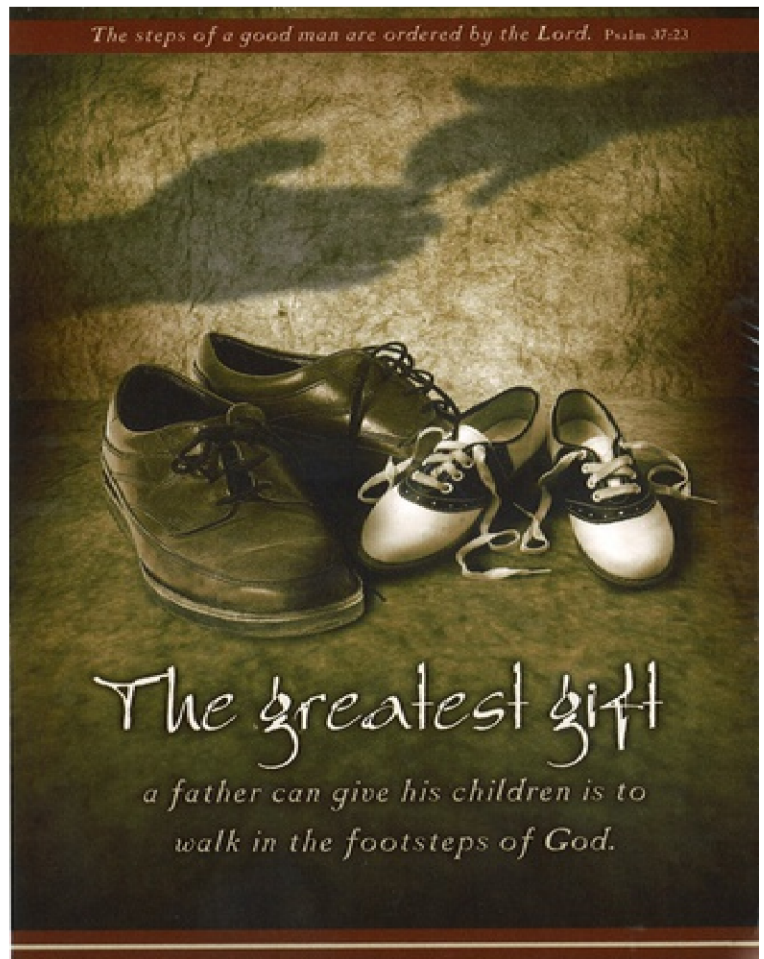
