Radical Love

Over the past several weeks, we have been discussing the overall theme of building a Christ-like image (Eph.5:1-2) in our Christian lives. In particular, we have studied the subject of loving one another because as Paul said to the brethren, "we are members of one another." One of the types of love that we will discuss today is what Jesus taught and lived, found in Matthew 5:20-48. The type of love He presents to His hearers that day was a radical love. Why teach them such a love, and why was it so important?

During that time, there was a natural feud going on between the different people of that day. There was a lot of hate and anger among the Jews and the Gentiles, the haves and have nots, the free and the slaves. It reminds one of the feud that happened between the two families in the 1800's, one in Kentucky and the other in West Virginia. They fought for nearly 20 years and 12 family members were killed. As you can see, once a feud starts, it can gradually damage and then destroy families, churches and lifelong relationships.

During Paul's ministry, he knew the deadly effects that feuds could have in a congregation. So, he reminds his readers in Ephesus, "We are members of one another" (Eph.4:25).

Is there a Christian with whom you are angry or bitter, with whom you no longer speak? Once perhaps you were friends, but have you let some offense turn your friend into an enemy? Once again, Paul continues to help us keep on the right track when it comes to the subject of love when he writes: "Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor and evil speaking be put away from you and all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another even as God in Christ forgave you." (Eph.4:31-32) Remember, living in harmony is God's way of living!
