## Help Me Be A Blessing

Part 2 - Help me be a blessing for the rest of my time and that I will make it count for eternity.

### **1Peter 4:1-11**

Last Sunday we asked the question, what kind of attitude can we cultivate in our lives to be the best we can be in our lifetime?

- I. First Attitude: Have a Soldiers' Attitude toward Sin – **1Peter 4:1-3**
  - II. Second Attitude: Have a Patient Attitude toward the Unsaved – **1Peter 4:4-6**
    - A. The unsaved will not understand when you say, "I've had enough. . ." vs.3
    - B. Why should we be patient? vs.4 see **2Corinthians 4:1-6**. When they attack you, why is it ok? see **1Peter 3:15**
  - III. Third Attitude: Have an expectation of Christ's return – **1Peter 4:7**
    - A. Why is it so important to have such an expectation of His return? see **Revelation 1:7**
    - B. Peter says, "be serious" (sober) while we live our lives as believers. **Romans 13:11-14; 1Timothy 3:2 Titus 2:1-6; Romans 14:8-13**
  - IV. Fourth Attitude: Have a fervent love for your church family. **1Peter 4:8-11**
    - A. Peter points out four important aspects to our love towards "one another" Our love should be fervent. vs.8 Our love should be hospitable vs.9 and our love will be seen in service to one another vs.10-11
    - B. How long is the rest of your lifetime?
- Conclusion: **Don't Waste It!**
