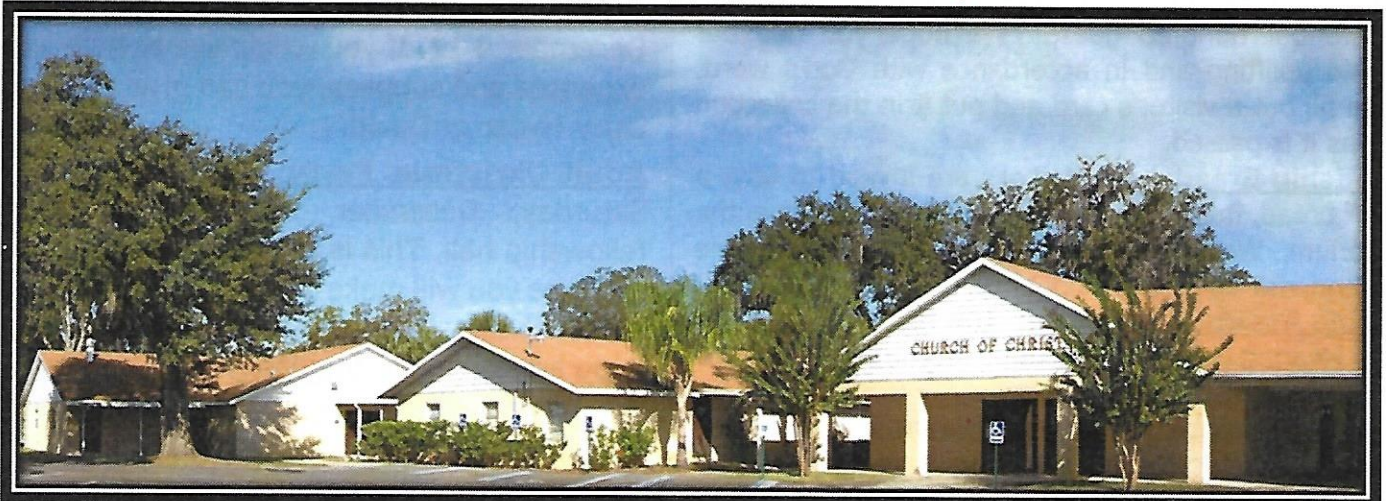

**Communion:** This is prepared anytime during the week before your Sunday, usually on Friday or Saturday. There are instructions in the room (the door in the front of the auditorium, on the right side of the stage).

**Make Friendship Bread:** We need 8 to 10 small (mini) loaves of bread or muffins per week. Just a simple (sweet bread) recipe without nuts is great. It can be from a mix; it doesn't have to be made from scratch. Breads like blueberry, banana or pumpkin are the best and easiest. The bread can be stored in the freezer if you make it quite a bit ahead of time, or you can make it and bring it to the building on the Friday or Saturday before and keep it in the frig in the fellowship hall kitchen.

**Hand Out Friendship Bread:** Usually, whoever makes the bread for that week, will also hand out the bread but we can adjust this as needed. If you need help handing the bread out, please let us know.

**The Toddler Class** is held in the education building and we leave to go over there with the children right after the Lord's Supper and Contribution. The children are ages 1 to 4 and we usually only have 3 or 4 children. You are with them for about 30 to 35 minutes and you do not have to prepare lessons or anything ahead of time to help. If you can sing "Jesus Loves Me" and read a Bible story out of a book, then you've got this!! The more we have sign up the less often your turn will be. 😊 Please see Reida Glenn or Sarah Myers for questions.

### Part 4

Help me continue to be blessing even though I suffer as a Christian.

1Peter 4:12-19

#### I. As a Christian: Jesus, help me learn from God's servant, Peter.

##### A. First, trials are to be expected, vs.12.

##### B. Second, rejoice and be exceeding glad, vs.13-14.

1. In vs.13, Peter says, "Be constantly rejoicing!"
2. 2Corinthians 8:1-5
3. Peter reveals four privileges as to why we can rejoice in the midst of fiery trials.
  - a. **First**, "the fellowship of His suffering" vs.13 Philippians 1:29; 3:10; Acts 5:25, 28, 29-32, 38-42

- b. **Second**, "the fellowship of His suffering" means glory in the future, vs.13; 1Peter 1:7-9; 5:1; John 16:20-22; Philippians 2:13-18; 3:20-4:1

- 
- c. **Third**, "the fellowship of His suffering" means that when Christians do suffer, the Holy Spirit rests in us, vs.14. Matthew 5:10-12

- 
- d. **Fourth**, "the fellowship of His suffering" gives us the privilege to glorify His name, vs.14. John 15:21; Matthew 16:18; Acts 4:12

**Conclusion:** Today, you can rejoice and gladly wear the name Christian.
