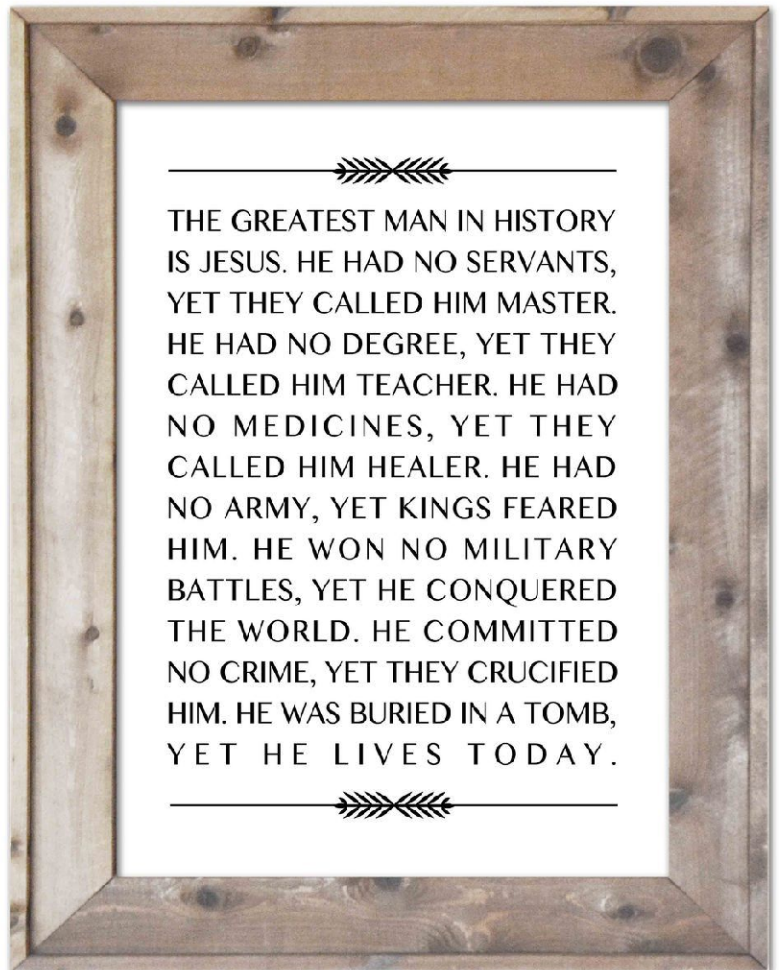

What Do You Think?

Introduction: In Acts 2:36-38, 39-41, we see how powerful the name of Jesus is. The author of the book of Acts reveals to us the beliefs and actions of the “called out” body of Christ in vs.42-47. In vs.47, it tells us that these early Christians “walked together” with gladness and simplicity of heart.” Why? see **Acts 3:6,16; 4:7,10,12,17,18,30.** These New Testament disciples of Jesus demonstrated “**The Power of His Name**” where they lived in **3 ways: Contrast, Conviction, and Conversion. Acts 3:1-10**

I. In Contrast: Christ is the reason – Acts 3:1-10

- A. The Christians were still meeting at the temple.
1. The contrast between Acts 2 & 3 is very clear.
 2. The events in chapter 3 are an illustration of the last phrase in **Acts 2:47.**
 3. This contrast in chapters 2 and 3, leads to only one conclusion: _____
- B. Beginning in vs.1, Peter and John worked together as a ministry team and make their way to the temple.
1. They had worked together before – **Luke 5:10; 22:8; John 20:3-4; Acts 8:14**
 2. They were, by example, the prayer of Jesus in John 17, being answered.
 3. Together, they meet a lame man outside the temple – Acts 3:1. What do we know about this man?
- C. At this time in his life, what 2 things did he need?
1. see **Acts 3:4-6** – He needed _____ and _____.
 2. see **Acts 3:7-10** – After his healing, what did he do?
 3. What do you think this man was thinking about Christ and His followers now? Acts 3:9-10
 4. see **Mark 16:15-20**

Conclusion: Now that this man could stand, there is no question where he stood. If Jesus is the reason for you being a disciple (saved in Christ) . . .

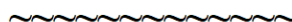
Pantry
