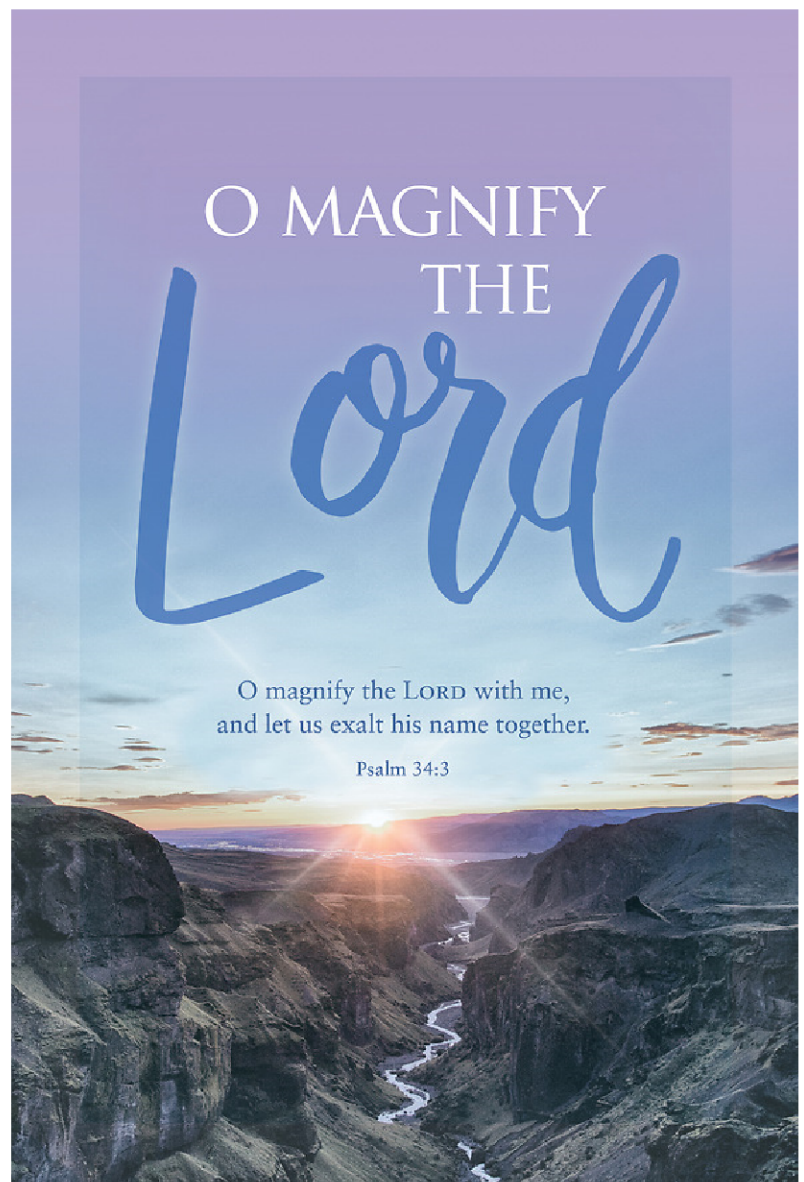

The Church

What Do You Think?

Introduction: What was the great concern of the 1st century Christians that were members of the church of Christ in Jerusalem? **Acts 1:7-8; 2:41-47** Peter and John, servants of Christ, ministered to a man in need at the temple. **Acts 3:1-10**. How was his life changed forever, that day? Let us turn our attention to what Peter said to those in the temple that were amazed at what they saw:

II. With conviction, Christ is the Son of God

Acts 3:11-16 Peter speaks to the Jews with Conviction – **vs.12-18**

A. Peter lays out the evidence as to why Jesus is the Son of God.

1. First comes the indictment – **vs.13**
2. Second, he used several names and titles to convince them that Jesus was no ordinary man – **vs.14-15**.
3. Third, he speaks to them about the empty tomb – **vs.15**. Where is Christ sitting now? **Colossians 1:13-14,18; Hebrews 12:28**
4. Fourth, he confirms the reason why they are guilty of sin – **vs.16,17,18; 4:14**.

B. Peter doesn't leave them hopeless. He presents **Christ as their Savior**. **Acts 3:18-26**

1. Now he will offer them God's conditions of pardon -**vs.19-26**. Like he did in **Acts 2:38**, what is the first thing he told them? **vs.19** First, they had to **repent** – **Acts 5:31; 17:30**. Next, he tells them to **turn** (be converted). Last, he announced what would happen if they repented and turned to the Lord - **vs.19**.
2. Was Peter telling these Jews to do something different from what he had commanded the Jews on Pentecost? **Acts 2:22-38** The answer is found also in **Mark 16:16; Acts 22:16**.

Conclusion: Peter's message that day produce two opposite results: Those that believed and obeyed, and those who rejected the message about Jesus. see **Acts 4:1-3, 4**
