Regarding the Coronavirus:

Dear Wildwood Family,

The elders at Wildwood want you to know that we are actively monitoring developments with the Coronavirus, we are paying close attention to what our health organizations recommend and we are making prayerful and intentional decisions. We want to care for our church family in all respects, including the physical well-being of our community. To that end, we are asking our families to take precautions to keep yourself and others safe, especially in light of recent developments. As the situation continues to unfold in the U.S. and in the state of Florida, we want to share with you some helpful precautions to promote health and well-being of our family here at Wildwood.

*We urge you to wash your hands often. It is proven that good old hand washing for at least 20 seconds is the best way to wash away germs. If soap and water are not available, use hand sanitizer. For your safety, we are taking extra care in thoroughly disinfecting hard surfaces and door-handles as much as possible.

*Starting next Sunday, March 22nd, we will have individual communion servings available to help prevent the spread of germs.

*We encourage everyone to wave to guests and members in large gatherings instead of shaking hands and hugging.

*Hospitals, nursing homes, rehabs, etc. are asking for no visitors during this time.

*Though we value your presence here more than we can express, if you are feeling sick, or have experienced symptoms such as fever, cough or body aches in the past 72 hours, we ask that you please stay home. The virus, in a young and otherwise healthy person, may be just a mild snuffle, cough or fever but it is far more dangerous for those with underlying health issues and for the elderly.

The uncertainty of this outbreak is creating anxiety with many people. Let us stay sensitive to those who are affected by this virus and set an example to others of what it looks like to find your peace, confidence and hope in Christ.
