Brad Harrub holds an earned B.S. degree in biology from Kentucky Wesleyan College, and an earned doctorate degree in anatomy and neurobiology from the College of Medicine at the University of Tennessee in Memphis. He has authored many books and articles. He is a professional apologist and travels all over the world speaking on Christian evidences, fortifying the family, and cultural apologetics. He has spoken in 49 states and in six continents, and conducts over 40 "Truth About Origins" weekend seminars each year. In addition, he was an invited speaker to the International conference on Creationism, and he has appeared on the television show "Origins."

Dr. Harrub has authored or co-authored numerous scientific publications in science journals and has done mission work in Russia, Ukraine, New Zealand, Ireland, Jamaica, Scotland, England, South Africa, Bermuda, Bahamas, Germany, Caymans, Canada, Trinidad, and Nicaragua. Currently, Dr. Harrub serves as the Executive Director and co-founder of Focus Press and as co-editor of Think magazine, a monthly magazine on Christian evidences. He and his wife, Melinda, attend the Southern Hills Church of Christ in Franklin, Tennessee. They have four children: Will (19), Reese (16), Claire (13), and Luke (10).
