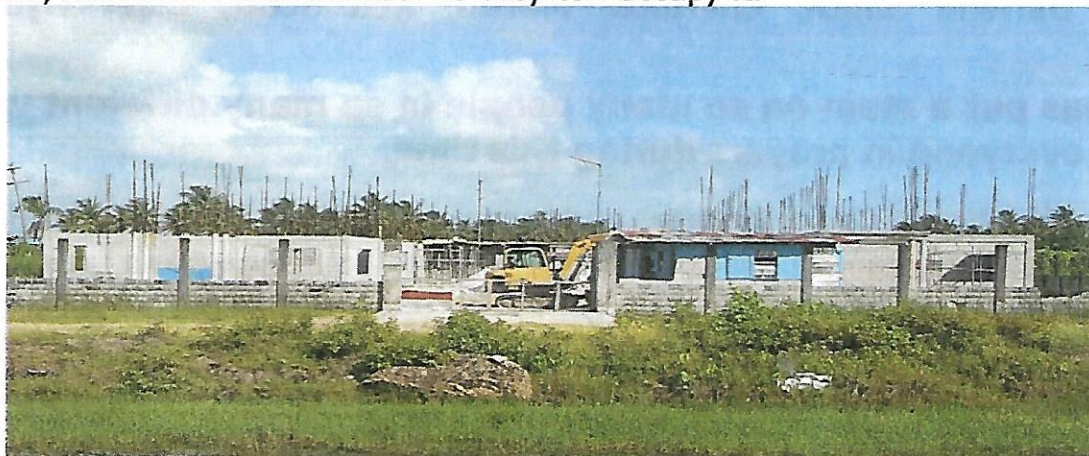
Hope Children's Home
