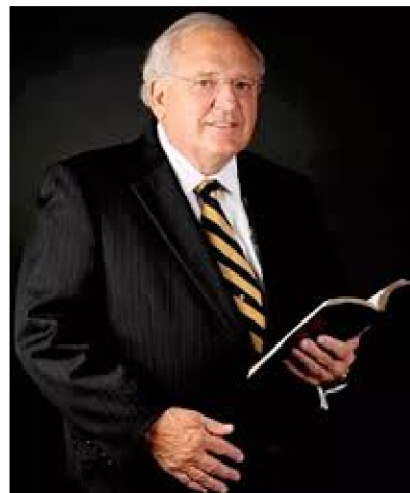

Jim Buck is home from rehab and doing better.

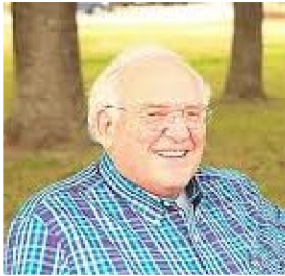
