Walking in the Fruit of the Spirit and What They Mean: (Galatians 5:22-23)

- *Love.* Not “butterflies in the stomach.” That’s Hollywood love. Biblical love is selflessly seeking the will of God for the one you love.
- *Joy.* The inner contentment we experience despite our external circumstances.
- *Peace.* Harmony in our human relationships.
- *Patience.* Most people think patience is passive, that it only refers to waiting; but patience also involves our ability to endure and our ability to forgo an impatient response when we are justly provoked. Patience is active; it means surrendering our right to hurt back when others hurt us.
- *Kindness and goodness.* These synonyms have different shades of meaning; however, they both connote loving treatment of those who don’t deserve it.
- *Faithfulness.* This means reliability in service; the kind of dependable commitment God can count on.
- *Gentleness (or meekness).* The ability to submit yourself to the will of God. The strongest man is not the one who forces his will upon others but the man who has that power and willingly surrenders it.
- *Self-Control.* The ability to resist fleshly impulses.
