**Galatians 5:1**

**Walking and Standing With The Truth**

**1 Timothy 1:3-11**

**3** As I urged you when I went into Macedonia--remain in Ephesus that you may charge some that they teach no other doctrine,

**4** nor give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which cause disputes rather than godly edification which is in faith.

**5** Now the purpose of the commandment is love from a pure heart, from a good conscience, and from sincere faith,

**6** from which some, having strayed, have turned aside to idle talk,

**7** desiring to be teachers of the law, understanding neither what they say nor the things which they affirm.

**8** But we know that the law is good if one uses it lawfully,

**9** knowing this: that the law is not made for a righteous person, but for the lawless and insubordinate, for the ungodly and for sinners, for the unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers,

**10** for fornicators, for sodomites, for kidnappers, for liars, for perjurers, and if there is any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine,

**11** according to the glorious gospel of the blessed God which was committed to my trust.

# CHRISTIANITY

## AS SEEN IN THE NEW TESTAMENT

Christianity as it came from the mind of God is clearly set forth in the New Testament.

The four gospels – Matthew, Mark, Luke and John – give us the account of the earthly life of Christ and His ministry, including His death for the sins of all mankind and His burial, resurrection, ascension and promised second coming to receive all of His faithful followers.

The fifth book of the New Testament – Acts of the Apostles – tells of the coming of the Holy Spirit on the apostles of Christ to guide them into all truth (in fulfillment of Jesus' promise to them before He left earth – see John 14-16), the establishment of the church on the day of Pentecost in Jerusalem, and the expansion of the church, particularly through the labors of the apostle Paul.

The books of Romans through Jude set forth the basis of man's justification from sin and give divine instructions to Christians as to how they are to live in the light of their redemption, how the church is to be organized and how it is to function in worship and work. These books also set forth many warnings about false teachers, false doctrines and a general falling away from the simplicity of the original faith of the gospel.

The last book of the New Testament – Revelation – describes the opposition Christians faced in the early church (and, in principle, the challenges they face in all ages) and the ultimate victory of the faithful people of God. -Hugh Fulford
