A Mother's Day

Godly mothers seek the welfare of her children before herself. She "watches over the ways of her household" with love (Prov. 31:27). Blessed is the family whose mother wraps her children in the security of warm affection and constant care (Titus 2:4).

A mother's day is a day of instruction.

Mothers are daily teachers of the next generation. Her words, values, and character are instilled in the hearts and lives of her children. Mothers, be careful to teach your children "with wisdom" and the "law of kindness" (Prov.31:26).

A mother's day is a day of devotion.

Hannah devoted herself to giving her son Samuel to the Lord (1 Sam.1:11, 22, 27-28). Your children will not be Christians by accident. Mothers, you have a tremendous part in the faith of your children. If you are not devoted to God, it is unlikely your children will be. Set them a godly example every day. They will "rise up and call (you) blessed" (Prov. 31:28).
