# A Job or a Ministry?

Some people have a JOB in the church; others involve themselves in a MINISTRY. What's the difference?

If you are doing it because no one else will do it, it's a job. If you are doing it to serve the Lord, it's a ministry.

If you quit because somebody criticized you, it was a job. If you keep on serving, it's a ministry.

If you'll do it as long as it does not interfere with your other activities, it's a job. If you are committed to staying with it even when it means letting go of other things, it's a ministry.

If you quit because no one praised you or thanked you, it was a job.

If you stay with it even when no one recognizes your efforts, it's a ministry.

It's hard to get excited about a job. It's almost impossible not to get excited about a ministry.

If our concern is success, it's a job. If our concern is faithfulness, it's a ministry.

An average church is filled with people doing jobs. A great and growing church is filled with people involved in ministry! Where do we fit in? What about us? If God calls you to do a ministry, don't treat it like a job. If you have a job, give it up and find a ministry. God does not want us to feel stuck with a job. He wants us excited and faithful to Him in ministry!
