Michael Clifton Adcock, Sr., 74 of The Villages, Florida, passed away June 10, 2018, in the comfort of his home. His family was by his side when he drifted off to be with the Lord. Mike was born to Mary Nell and Tommy "Tip" Adcock, of Baltimore, Maryland, on December 25, 1943.

As a faithful Christian, Mike was a very active member at the Wildwood Church of Christ where he served as a previous Deacon. Professionally, he dedicated his life to serving his country. In 1995, Mike retired from the National Security Agency after more than 30 years of selfless service. Mike also served 11 years in the United States Army and was honorably discharged as a Staff Sergeant, in 1973. Mike was blessed with a phenomenal career where he spent many years overseas in England, Spain, Iran, Afghanistan, Ethiopia, and Guam, and even further distinguished himself serving in the Defense Attaché Office of several U.S. Embassies.
