Shelters all from pain and strife.*

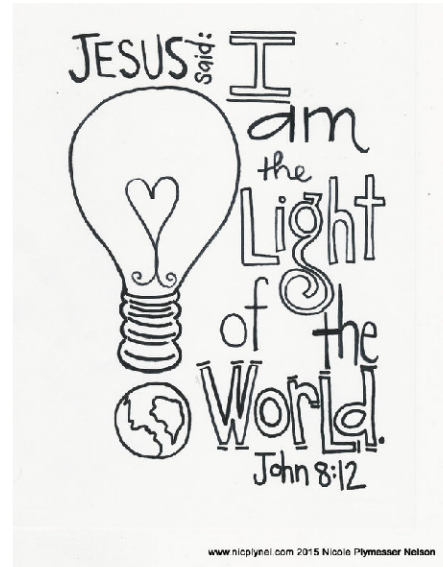
*There no sun nor moon shall lighten,
