## Be The Change!

### Be Willing to Lead! Ezekiel 22:23-30

“<sup>23</sup> And the word of the Lord came to me, saying, <sup>24</sup> ‘Son of man, say to her: “You are a land that is not cleansed or rained on in the day of indignation.” <sup>25</sup> The conspiracy of her prophets in her midst is like a roaring lion tearing the prey; they have devoured people; they have taken treasure and precious things; they have made many widows in her midst. <sup>26</sup> Her priests have violated My law and profaned My holy things; they have not distinguished between the holy and unholy, nor have they made known the difference between the unclean and the clean; and they have hidden their eyes from My Sabbaths, so that I am profaned among them. <sup>27</sup> Her princes in her midst are like wolves tearing the prey, to shed blood, to destroy people, and to get dishonest gain. <sup>28</sup> Her prophets plastered them with untampered mortar, seeing false visions, and divining lies for them, saying, “Thus says the Lord God,” when the Lord had not spoken. <sup>29</sup> The people of the land have used oppressions, committed robbery, and mistreated the poor and needy; and they wrongfully oppress the stranger. <sup>30</sup> **So I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it; but I found no one.**”

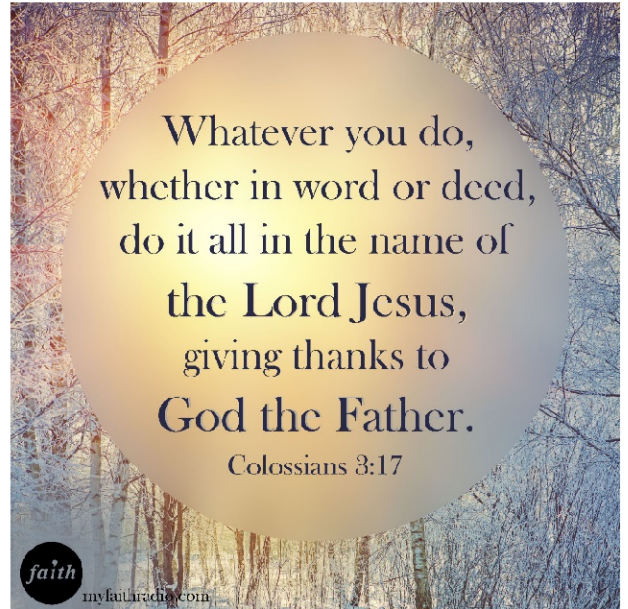
