

In August of 2022, our beloved Kellie Ward was diagnosed with stage 4 metastatic breast cancer with areas that metastasized to her lungs and liver. Initially, she tolerated the treatment well and was able to live a relatively normal life, working as the secretary for her church while undergoing chemo. In July of 2023, the cancer built up a resistance to the chemo and they found that it had spread to her brain and developed a new spot on her liver. She had to undergo a craniotomy to remove a large tumor, and then quickly began targeted radiation for numerous spots throughout her brain. Most recently, they have found new spots on her lungs and liver, and had to change her chemo treatment to hopefully combat this. There have been many ups and downs throughout this journey, and Kellie has drastically lost her quality of life during the process. She is unable to work or drive, and has difficulty carrying out basic tasks of daily living. We are stepping out in faith and wanting to make a radical change in regards to Kellie's treatment in order to fight this cancer more effectively and to regain her overall well-being.

Through the help of a friend who also is battling stage 4 cancer, we have found Brio Medical, a specialized cancer center in Scottsdale Arizona. They specialize in treating stage 3 and 4 cancers by combining conventional cancer therapies, alternative and complementary therapies, lifestyle modifications, and supportive care. The facility has a high success rate of eradicating cancer and improving the overall well-being of their patients. We have met with the center via Zoom and they believe she is a good candidate and would greatly benefit from their treatment.

Unfortunately, insurance does not cover these integrative treatment programs and we need your help to get Kellie to this facility. The program is 7 weeks, and the funds will be used to pay for the program, and for airfare, housing and food while Kellie is there in Arizona. Any contribution to this fund would be immensely appreciated, either through GoFundMe or directly to my parents, David & Sarah Myers. If you are unable to contribute financially, we ask that you give by spreading the word to all your friends and family. We also ask that you continue to pray fervently for Kellie in her battle, and for God to guide us as we take this new step.
