Acts 4:32

I read several years ago about the entertainer, Jimmy Durante, from an article written by Tim Hansel. Durante was asked to be a part of a show for World War II veterans. He told them his schedule was very busy and he could only stay a few minutes. He agreed to do a short monologue then immediately leave for his next appointment.

When Mr. Durante got on stage, something interesting happened. He did his short monologue but then stayed. The applause grew louder and louder and he kept staying. Finally, he took a last bow and left the stage. Someone stopped him and said, "I thought you had to leave after a few minutes. What happened?" Jimmy answered, "I did have to go, but I can show you the reason why I stayed. You can see for yourself if you will look on the front row." In the front row were two men, veterans, each of whom had lost an arm in the war. One had lost his right arm and the other soldier had lost his left arm. As one, they were able to clap and that's exactly what they were doing, loudly and cheerfully.

Well, that story illustrates what Luke, the writer of Acts 4:32-37, wrote about the disciples of Christ in Jerusalem. These new Christians illustrate how believers should not only encourage one another, but it also contains a beautiful lesson of followers of Jesus being united and fulfilling the prayer of Jesus recorded in John 17. It is so important that every member in our fellowship be involved and each member contribute to the spiritual and numerical growth of the Lord's church, His kingdom. We should be reminded of Israel when they were at war against Amalek (Exodus 17). Moses is on top of a hill, staff of God in his hand, holding it up. As long as Moses' hands were up, Israel prevailed. But when he let his hands down, Amalek prevailed. Verse 12 says, "Moses' hands were heavy." So Aaron and Hur supported his hand and God's people won a victory. Moses built an altar and called its name, "The Lord Is My Banner" (YHWH Nissi) Exodus 17:15
