ARE YOU MOTIVATED?

Several years later, the Army conducted an experiment to see if that original feet could be duplicated. They offered a similar unit an extra week's furlough – an attractive incentive – if they could carry out a comparable mission without a hitch. But the second unit could not match the success of the first. What made the difference? The lives of the men of the men were not at stake. ??? Surviving in battle was a greater motivation than a week's vacation.

Solomon declares in Proverbs 9:10-12, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding. For by me your days will be multiplied, and years of life will be added to you. If you are wise, you are wise for yourself, and if you scoff, you will bear it alone."

The more we read His word, the more of it we memorize and the more thoroughly we dig deep into it, the more effective we will be in our walk with God and the spread of His Son's church and kingdom.
