## "Be His Servant!"

For it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure. Philippians 2:13; see also Ephesians 1:5-6, 7

Because we are God's children and His servants, can we draw upon the riches of His grace to serve in His Kingdom? The answer is found in Paul's letters to the brethren:

**Ephesians 1:7** In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

**Ephesians 2:7** that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

**Ephesians 3:16** that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man,

**Philippians 4:19** And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

**Ephesians 3:8** To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ,

**Ephesians 2:4** But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us

**2Corinthians 9:8** And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.

**2Corinthians 9:9-11 9** As it is written: "He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." **10** Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, **11** while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.
