## Theme for June: "BE HIS BRIDE!" His Word Bearing Fruit

Jonathan Edwards wrote the following, back in the 1700's:

You are all called to be Christians, and this is your profession. Endeavour, therefore, to acquire knowledge in things which pertain to your profession. Let not your teachers have cause to complain, that while they spend and are spent, to impart knowledge to you, you take little pains to learn. It is a great encouragement to an instructor, to have such to teach as make a business of learning, bending their minds to it. This makes teaching a pleasure, when otherwise it will be a very heavy and burdensome task.

It was a practice of Edwards to spend as many as thirteen hours in study of God's Word. But he didn't regard the circumstances of knowledge as an end in itself. As a minister of the Word of God, he longed to see the seeds of his preaching bear godly fruit among his brethren and in his own life. Like all teachers of the Scriptures, he wanted affirmation that his labors were not in vain.

Have you ever considered the encouragement that teachers of God's Word receive when their listeners get excited about learning? Is God's Word, provided to you that you have been reading daily throughout this year, making a difference in your life? Now that you are getting a steady diet of the Scriptures, savoring the Truth, digesting it, bringing much benefit to your growth as a Christian, what should you do next? Thank the Father above for sending His Word!

If God's Word isn't producing fruit in your life, this may be the time to do some evaluating. This would be a good time to examine your personal learning habits. Are you delving into the Word regularly on your own? Are you applying what you learn – allowing the Bible's principles to weave themselves into the fabric of everyday living? Or are you simply accumulating knowledge? It's very important to realize that change rarely takes place overnight; growing in Christ is a lifelong endeavor. Solomon reminds us all, "He who gives attention to the Word shall find good, and blessed is he who trusts in the Lord." Proverbs 16:20
