# When God Looks Down

When we look above at night, we are not able to see the International Space Station, with our eyes, but there is something special about that station, 200 miles above the earth. There are men and women working together for the good of all, from different nations, ethnic groups and ideology.

When God looks down on us, made in His image and likeness (Galatians 1:26-27), He sees no borders that divide the many nations on earth. He doesn't see such distinctions. The important thing to Him is that all will love Him and each other (Mark 12:30-31). What He does want is for His spiritual family, the church of His Son, to be united. We cannot accomplish what God has for us to do if we refuse to be reconciled with one another. In the Lord's most impassioned prayer, on the night before He was crucified, He pleaded with His Father to unite His followers: "That they all may be one, as You Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us" (John 17:21).

It binds us together in peace, proclaiming God's power and greatness through praise and demonstrates God's glory to the world.
