Ten Prayers To Pray Over Husbands and Fathers

Father's Day is a very special opportunity to pray to the heavenly Father to bless a very special person. Look at these 10 prayers to pray over our fathers using God's word:

1. Pray for his work – Proverbs 22:29 "Do you see a man who excels in his work?"
2. Pray for his heart, soul and mind – Psalm 107:9 "For He satisfies the longing soul, and fills the hungry soul with goodness."
3. Pray for healing the past – Jeremiah 17:14 "Heal me, O Lord, and I will be healed; save me, and I will be saved, for You are my praise."
4. Pray for Courage – Proverbs 19:23 "The fear of the Lord leads to life; and whoever has it, rests satisfied."
5. Pray for leadership – James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God; who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly and it will be given to him."
6. Pray for wisdom in finances – Hebrews 13:5 "Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have."
7. Pray for a heart for the Lord – Ephesians 6:6 "Don't work only while being watched, as people-pleasers, but as slaves of Christ, do God's will from your heart."
8. Pray for his speech – Ephesians 4:29 "Let no corrupt word (foul language) proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers."
