His Workmanship

Beginning July 1st, our theme for the month will be “Be His Servant”. Why? The reason is because it matters to God, that as Christians we do what pleases Him. Paul confirms this in Philippians 2:12-13, “Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.”

The word “work” in both verses refers to the fact that we, as His workmanship (Ephesians 2:10), be actively involved in His kingdom as His servants. Please consider the following thought-provoking statement shared by the publication called *The Averill Visitor*.

When it is announced that someone is sick do you: send them a card, offer help, visit them at the hospital, or get irritated with announcements about people you don’t even know?

When new souls are added to the Lord, do you: introduce yourself and welcome them, visit and encourage them?

When there isn’t enough social activity, do you: invite groups of Christians into your home, plan & carry out activities for adults or children, help with activities already planned?

When no one seems to be friendly, do you: Become a friend to someone in need, make it your place to greet visitors, invite people who are weak into your home?

When Bible classes are provided, do you: Attend faithfully and encourage others to attend, prepare your lesson, contribute to the class discussion, or sit with your mouth closed waiting for the class to be more interesting?

When someone is absent from the assembly, do you: Call to find out why, exhort and encourage them, offer transportation, or even notice that they are missing?

When there is a special program, do you: Help advertise the meeting, invite others to come, invite the guest speaker into your home for a meal, support the effort with your attendance, or ignore the whole thing?

Now, from what activity do you feel you have been excluded?
