As you may know, the television arena is an ever-changing and growing portal to reach people all across the world. Many people have made lifestyle changes in which they have utilized technology more and more for entertainment, but also, most importantly - learning. You may ask what the good news is. Well, we would like to share several updates with you about The Gospel of Christ program, our broadcast markets and future plans.

Within the past several months, we have had a LOT of changes in the program, including moving to a new facility on the property of the Red Hill church of Christ in Manchester, TN. A new studio and set was built from the ground up to "freshen up" the look and feel a bit. We have also entered into an agreement with **WGN America** to broadcast the program in every television market in the United States! You will also find us on all of the major streaming devices and online portals for on-demand video such as Vimeo and youTube, Roku, AppleTV, FireTV, our own branded app, including special guest series, archived episodes of *The Truth in Love*, and more.

This is a very exciting time for us as we begin to launch on WGN America. We will be seen across the country beginning June 14 at 6:30 a.m. ET/PT and 5:30 a.m. CT/MT on Sunday mornings. What is even better is that we are going to be the lead-in program to a very popular program that you may already view. We will be broadcasting just before our good friend and brother Phil Sanders with *In Search*. That means that almost 85 million households will have a back-to-back powerhouse of solid truth in teaching the gospel! **We ask that you display the brochure on the back of this letter, as well as make announcements and post in your bulletin, web, and other areas of interest.**

As you can see, there are a lot of great things happening. **We need your help!** This new national broadcast will consume much of our budget for broadcasting currently. We will actually be increasing our total broadcast budget by about \$5,000 per month to be able to stay on various local markets as well on major networks where we have congregations that provide support for local broadcasts.

With that said, we would also like to ask for your help in this endeavor. This more than doubles our potential reach currently and we have been told that the estimates of viewers during this particular broadcast is phenomenal. We hope and pray that much good comes from this huge announcement and undertaking. Supporting congregations are also listed on our website that sees anywhere from 10,000 to 18,000 visitors per month!
