## It's Hard To Decide

The apostle Paul is often portrayed by many scholars as the theologian of the cross. We will find in our study on the resurrection, that all of his teaching on the atonement would have been as nothing without the resurrection of Christ.

The Christ crucified, whom Paul proclaimed (see 1Corinthians 1:18-2:5) was one and the same, the risen Christ. Indeed, it was his encounter with the risen Christ that led to his conversion and proved to be the basis for his calling as an apostle: "God . . . was pleased to reveal His Son in me, so that I might preach Him among the Gentiles" (Galatians 1:15-16). The resurrection of Jesus was the essence of the Pauline gospel.

One of the difficulties that a Christian will face when he or she wants to study beyond the two "must" chapters in Paul's letters, 1Corinthians 15 and 2Corinthians 5, is to decide what other passages to study. Please consider for your further study on this topic the following scriptures in the coming weeks:
