What A Difference A Day Makes

M. Norvel Young, in his book, <u>Living Lights, Shining Stars</u>, tells the story of Captain Scott O'Grady who experienced firsthand the profound impact of helping someone in need. When his F-16 was shot down over Bosnia in 1995, the U.S. Airforce captain ejected into the desert. He survived in hostile territory for six days and nights by eating insects and grass and drinking rainwater. Everyone thought he was dead, until Captain Thomas Hanford, a member of the search crew, heard him respond to his radio call sign, "Basher 52".

Scott said, "I felt goose bumps all over, electricity rushing through me. I wanted to laugh and scream and cry and jump for joy, everything short of an Irish jig. Hanford had been fluing all night and was finished with his schedule. But he had extra gas and could stay out another ten to twenty minutes. He could have gone home. I'm really glad he didn't go home."

As a result of Captain Hanford's extra effort, Scott was picked up in a dramatic daylight rescue. And he came home with a new resolve to put more balance in his life: "to myself and to do as much as I could for others."

Make-a-Difference-Day is one of the ways Scott tries to help others, out of gratitude for the way he was helped. And we all need to realize what a difference a day may make in the lives of those with whom we come into contact. The Psalmist said in 118:24, "This is the day which the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it." One of the ways we can rejoice and be glad each day is by trying to make a difference with an act of kindness, a good deed.

One suggestion is to take some of the tracts we have available and distribute them to as many people and places we can. Leave one with your trip at the restaurant. Mail one with each household bill when you pay it. Leave some on the tables in waiting rooms of doctors, dentists, attorneys, and other professionals when you are in their offices.

We may never know what impact they might have. That simple act may make a significant difference in the life of another person. Try it! Remember, "doing what is right makes a nation great" (Proverbs 14:34).
