Simple Faith: Back Then and Now

When it comes to paying taxes to the U.S. government, which is just around the corner, it can be very complex and confusing. When was the last time you took the time to study the U.S. Internal Revenue Service income tax regulations? According to Forbes magazine, the tax code has now surpassed the four-million word mark. As you can see, the regulations have become burdensome – that even the experts have a hard time processing all the regulations.

When it comes to the subject of faith and how it works, it doesn't have to be complex and hard to understand, to the one seeking to understand it.

During the ancient times of the Israelite nation, through the years, the Jewish leaders made it difficult to understand how one's relationship with God worked. They made the law of God very complex and burdensome by adding to the law with their many man-made traditions and commandments. During the ministry of Jesus, one such Jewish leader asked Him what mattered most in the commandments. Jesus answered him, "The first of all the commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." Mark 12:29-31

The law given to Moses did not have to be complex and burdensome, because faith in God back under the Old Covenant, was based on a simple trust and faith in His word and an obedient response to what He said to do, and that principle has not changed under the New Covenant. Under the New Covenant, we put our faith in Christ that died on the cross on our behalf (John 8:34); we repent of our sins that caused Him to go to the cross (Luke 13:3,5; Acts 17:30-31); confess that He is the Christ, the Son of God (Matthew 10:31-32; Romans 10:9-10); and be baptized for the forgiveness of our sins (Acts 2:38: 22:16; Mark 16:16; Romans 6:3-5; 1Peter 3:21). From that day forward, we walk in faith to the One that enables us to love Him with all our heart, soul, mind and strength and love our neighbor as ourselves. Do not let your walk with God become a burden and become complex. Matthew 11:30 says that "His burden is light" and He also says that He "will give you rest" as you walk with Him each day in faith.
