## When You Don't Feel Like It

We all struggle with spiritual discouragement and lethargy. Some days, our circumstances threaten to overwhelm us, and we struggle just to pray. Many times, we just don't feel like doing the things we know we should. For one reason or another, God sometimes seems far off and unreachable.

David faced times like these in his life. The Psalms are filled with verses expressing his feelings of despair and abandonment. Yet the Psalms also give us the key to living victoriously during the dark periods of life. Let's take a quick look at Psalm 119:89-95.

"Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in Heaven. Your faithfulness endures to all generations; You established the earth, and it abides. They continue this day according to Your ordinances. . ."

My circumstances or feelings have not changed God. He is the same God today as He was when He hung the stars in the sky, led the Israelites through the Red Sea, and fed the five thousand.

"For all are Your servants . . ."

All things, even those affecting me right now, are God's servants. The circumstances, people and events around me are all under God. They are His servants, designed to help and bless me spiritually.

"Unless Your law had been my delight, I would then have perished in my affliction. I will never forget Your precepts, For by them You have given me life. I am Yours, save me; For I have sought Your precepts. The wicked wait for me to destroy me, But I will consider Your testimonies."

Recalling God's faithfulness and control over everything that touches us gives us strength to walk with God even when we feel like giving up in despair. Our feelings and circumstances have not changed God. He is perfectly capable of sustaining us if we will only let Him. We simply need to choose to delight in and diligently consider God's precepts – His principles and character – despite how we feel. Choosing to delight in God might not be easy and may even involve hard work, but only God can revive and save our souls from spiritual lethargy.

Next time you feel spiritually drained or inadequate, remember that you have a choice. You can wrap yourself up in excuses and self-pity, or you can choose to draw your strength from an unchanging God.
