The book of Job records many questions that God asks and also questions that Job asks. When Job was with his so-called friends, he asked them questions that referred to his present sufferings of the loss of his family, his health and his possessions. One of his questions was, "Why is light given to him who is in misery and life to the bitter of soul?" (Job 3:20) Later he asks, "What strength do I have, that I should hope?" (Job 6:11) and then he asked, "Does it seem good to You that You should oppress?" (Job 10:3)

Many have asked similar questions when tragedy strikes and the loss of a loved one happens without warning. These types of situations that we face will lead us to ask God any number of questions: "Why did You let this happen?" "Don't You care about my pain?" "Whose fault was this?"

What is interesting about the book of Job is that when you read to the end of the book, there is a surprise. God responds to Job (chapters 38-41) and asks him some questions – many questions that show His sovereignty, His magnificent creation – all pointing to the fact that He is love, all-powerful, and He knows what He is doing. Now that Job is reminded that God is in control, he says to the Lord God, "I know that You can do everything, and that no purpose of Yours can be withheld from You. You asked, "Who is this who hides counsel without knowledge?" Therefore, I have uttered what I did not understand, things too wonderful for me, which I did not know." (Job 42:1-3) Psalm 2:12 says, "Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him." May the message

of Job bring you comfort and blessings knowing that God knows best and the He loves you!
