December's Prayer

Lord, Help Me Have Your Peace

2Thessalonians 3:16-18

In Paul's letters to the brethren, he refers to God the Father with six different titles:

1. God of patience and consolation – Romans 15:5
2. God of hope – Romans 15:13
3. God of all comfort – 2Corinthians 1:3
4. God of our Lord Jesus Christ – Ephesians 1:3
5. God of love – 2Corinthians 13:11
6. God of peace – Romans 15:33, 16:20

Of these, he refers to only one more than once – “the God of peace” which he uses five times. Here in 2Thessalonians 3:16, Paul attributes this same quality to our Lord Jesus Christ. Paul must have realized the role “peace” plays in our understanding of the nature of God and Christ's victory on the cross. This prayer that we will all participate in this month is a simple and straightforward one: May the Lord of Peace Himself, our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ:

1. Continually grant you His peace – the peace of living in His kingdom and will – in all situations and in every circumstance no matter what you face.
2. Be with you always – may you feel His presence at all times.

“The Lord of peace Himself give your peace always (by all means) in every way. The Lord be with you all.” 2Thessalonians 3:16
