Dear Brethren,

We live in perilous times. It has been said that this is the year that never should have been. This year has been a disaster for the Lord's work in India, following what was the most productive year ever for our team's efforts in 2019. Last year, we conducted a record number of 1-day Gospel meetings and had the greatest visible response ever to our work in India.

We had hoped to build on that for this year ~ but in mid-March, the wheels started to come off. Right now, corona virus in the areas where we do most of our work may have peaked, but the fact is that a number of our brethren are dying in their villages with little or no medical treatment. At this writing, we have assisted 174 widows of preachers who have expired since April 1st.

This is why your gift has been so important to our efforts ~ and why we are so grateful for it. We are not only involved in the preaching of the Gospel and training preachers ~ we are helping our brethren in times of critical need. At this time, many of our brethren are suffering from the lack of food. We are helping as many as possible with a small gift of 5,000 rupees ~ about \$70. These 2 different benevolent works not only help our brethren; it shows them that we really do care about them in their time of need.

So, thank you again for your contribution to our efforts in India. You will never know how truly grateful we are. Most of all, you will never know how grateful our Indian brethren are when they receive your assistance. Without caring brothers and sisters like you, we simply could not aide these brethren. God bless you for caring ~ and sharing.
