Paul's prayer here is unique in all of his writings. He simply prays that the effectiveness of Philemon's sharing of the word of God would match and grow with his knowledge of who he was – and as a result, what he had "in Christ."

4 I thank my God, making mention of you always in my prayers, *s* hearing of your love and faith which you have toward the Lord Jesus and toward all the saints, *6* that the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus. *7* For we have great joy and consolation in your love, because the hearts of the saints have been refreshed by you, brother.
