A BRIEF HISTORY OF

THE WILDWOOD CHURCH BUILDING IN

Although there had been some discussions about building a new church building in Wildwood for some time, it appears that at the men's meeting of 2/5/80, some serious thought was put forth with regard to remodeling the present auditorium or building a new auditorium.

After the mid-week services on Wednesday, June 24, 1981, Charles W. Brewer made a presentation regarding a new building.

At the men's meeting of January 16, 1986, a building committee was formed to look into the possibility of securing a builder and finance for the proposed new building. That committee was made up of: H. Bone, H. Jones, L. LeMasters J. Glenn, D. Andrews & L. Martin, plus W. Cook.

After many meetings, it was decided on May 15, 1986 to have Christian Builders build our church building and Florida National Bank of Wildwood would finance this venture beginning with a loan @ 81/10.

With the blessings of our elders; L. Martin, G. Mullins & F. Sandh, ground was cleared and construction began June, 1986. Christian Builders had predicted that it would take six months to complete; however, Bruce Smithers indicated that he could finish in four months. As fact would indicate, Bruce was right, because we had our first service in the new building in October, 1986.

It is also interesting to note that our mortgage was completely paid off in February, 1995 - thus enabling us to support our mission field work more adequately.

July 1986 – We moved our worship service to the all-purpose room in the Sunday school class building. The pews were removed from the old building and placed in the room, rather close quarters at that. We continued to worship here for about two and a half months until the new auditorium was completed.





August 1986 – With the roof on, the inside remains to be finished. At least the weather would not be a factor.







August 1986 – With the old building torn down and the debris hauled off, our own Chester Strickland with all of his skill and equipment, cleaned off the front yard and parking lot at no cost to the church.







August 1986 – A problem arose where the old building connected with the Sunday school class building, but it was quickly solved with stucco. Everything was progressing smoothly.









September 1986 – Things are really looking good and everything shaping up. It now appears that October will be the finish date.












October, 1986 - The final touches are being applied. The building will soon be ready for our first worship service.















October 1986 – One of our very first services in the new building.
