  - A. Nurturing Christians "in the faith."
    - 1. God established a model for ministry in His larger family The church of Jesus Christ (**Romans 16:16**).
    - 2. Paul used His approach in his letters to bring his brethren to a greater measure of maturity.
      - a. "Mother-child" relationship (I Thessalonians 2:7) What do these words by Paul communicate to his brethren? Was Paul a single man?
      - b. "Father-child" relationship (I Thessalonians 2:10-11) Do fathers have a responsibility to nurture their children? (Ephesians 6:4) What influenced Paul in this area? See Deuteronomy 6:6-9
      - c. The picture is clear that God planned for the church to be nurtured like a mother and father would nurture their children.

        - ii. Galatians 4:19
    - 3. As Christians, what should be our leadership style when trying to lead others to Christ?
      - a. I Peter 5:2-3
      - b. II Timothy 2:23-25

# B. The church, the family, and individuals

- 1. The larger group would be the local church.
  - a. The New Testament is in essence the "story of the church of Jesus Christ."
    - i. Matthew 16:18-19

- b. Jesus Christ and the twelve apostles (Matthew 28:18-20, Ephesians 2:19-22)
- 2. The family unit within the local church (**Ephesians 5:21-32, 6:1-4**, **Colossians 3:18-21**)
- 3. The marital relationship (Ephesians 5:22-32, Colossians 3:18-21)
- 4. The church made up of individuals (I Corinthians 7:8-40, I Timothy 5:1-16)

### C. The servant leaders in the local church

- 1. God intended these leaders to work as a team, with different roles to fulfill.
- 2. Acts 14:21-23, 20:17, 28 (15:6, 22; 21:18)
- 3. Ephesians 4:11, Romans 12:4-8
- 4. I Timothy 3:1-13, Titus 1:5-9, I Peter 5:1-4 (see Philippians 1:1, Hebrews 13:7, 17)
- D. Intended results A unique team A partnership!

  - 2. Example: Aquila and Priscilla (Acts 18-1-4, 18-26, I Corinthians 16:19, Romans 16:3-4
